It was founded in Melbourne in 2003 by Andrew Heslop after the remains of an elderly woman were found inside her suburban home. She had been dead for 2 years before she was discovered, and yet no one seemed to notice or care.

Jesus thought neighbours were important to us, which is why he told us to love our neighbours. Of course he meant more than the people in our street, but our street and suburb are good places to start.

On Neighbour day, why not help build a strong and supportive community in your street by having a party or inviting the neighbours to a bbq in a park nearby or in your yard?
