Serpents and doves among wolves....

“You go as sheep to wolves” – *Phil Jackson, Chicago Bulls Coach, 1998*

It won't be easy: you're going amongst wolves (10:16a)

Therefore #1: be as shrewd as serpents and as *innocent* as doves (10:16b-25)

Therefore #2: set aside your fear of the wolves (10:26-31)

Because:

(1) We have the revealed message to bring that can't be hidden

(2) Fear of God trumps fear of man

(3) God's in control and He values you
